Scholarships

The Knox-Gingrich Endowed Scholarship is a fully funded endowed scholarship providing an award of up to \$1000 to a senior student interested in dairy production medicine.

The Country Roads Veterinary Services Summer Externship Scholarship is awarded to up to two students each year. Qualified students in the summer between CVM2 and CVM3 are encouraged to apply for this two week externship. Housing is provided. At the end of the externship, the student is awarded a scholarship of \$500-1500 utilizing matching funds from the OVMA Food Animal Externship Program.
